Najwa Muftah Najwa Muftah is a British scholar of Palestinian identity, gender and the Arab world, and is the author of two books on the subject. She was a member of the Academic Advisory Board of the Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission in London, and is a member of the advisory board for the Centre for Education and Skills Development in Palestine and a member of the board of the Palestinian Youth Centre in Brussels. Early life Mufah was born in the United Kingdom. She grew up in the middle class Palestinian city of Ramallah, West Bank, where she attended the American College of the West Bank. She did her M.A in International Relations at the University of Leeds, and her PhD in sociology at the University of Edinburgh. Education and career Muftah gained an MA in International Relations from the University of Leeds and an MSc in Sociology from the University of Edinburgh. She became a lecturer at the department of Sociology, Birzeit University in the Palestinian West Bank. She taught at Birzeit University from 1987-94, and at the American University in Cairo (AUC) from 1995-99. She currently teaches at Columbia University, New York. Najwa Muftah is a professor of sociology at Columbia University. She specializes in Middle East Studies, including gender and women in the Arab world, as well as Palestinian studies. She has been one of the most influential voices for gender equality in the Arab world. Her research has been funded by The European Commission, The British Council, The International Fund for Women, The Rockefeller Foundation, and the Carnegie Foundation. Her first book was entitled *We Will Not Surrender: Resisting Israeli Colonialism in Palestine* (University of California Press, 2004). Her second book, *Arab Women, Men and the Middle East* was published in 2005.
