The databases of MEDLINE, Cochrane Library, PsychINFO and CINAHL were searched in January 2012. We included randomised and non-randomised controlled trials of childhood cancer involving children under 18 years of age that reported on cognition or quality of life. Studies were evaluated for methodological validity and risk of bias. Twenty-one studies were included, of which 12 (57%) showed some degree of cognitive impairment. Twenty-one (56%) reported quality of life impairment. The cognitive impairment rate was similar in non-randomised (59%) and randomised studies (62%). Poor quality studies were more likely to report cognitive impairment (odds ratio [OR] = 5.8, 95% confidence interval [CI]: 1.8-18.8) or quality of life impairment (OR = 3.7, 95% CI: 1.9-7.3) than good quality studies. Children who received chemotherapy were more likely to have neurocognitive impairments (OR = 3.2, 95% CI: 1.6-6.6) and quality of life impairments (OR = 3.1, 95% CI: 2.2-4.4) than other children. More children with cancer than in control groups were identified with cognitive impairment (OR = 7.8, 95% CI: 3.1-19.8) or quality of life impairment (OR = 9.3, 95% CI: 3.4-25.4). This review highlighted that many children with cancer suffer from cognitive impairment and quality of life impairment. Children who received chemotherapy were more likely to have these impairments., therefore, that courts should look to the most significant factors. Id. The Dodge and Burn tools are useful for adding more interest to an image. The Dodge tool lightens the image, and the Burn tool darkens it. The Gradient tool allows you to add color or gradients. It works very much like the Paint Bucket tool, but it can paint a gradient instead. The Gradient Palette tool allows you to use a color gradient to add a fade to an image. It can be used on any image type (including vector-based images). The HUE/Saturation tool allows you to alter the colors of an image. It works by increasing or decreasing the color saturation. The Brush tool allows you to paint and shape images with a brush. It works as you would expect, but it's actually a few steps away from the real Photoshop. There are quite a few other things you can do using the Brush tool (for example, you can add decorative patterns with the Brush Distortion tool). Many parts of the interface are inaccessible without the Magic Wand tool. The Magnify tool allows you to make a selection around objects or whole areas of an image.
