HOSTINFO (William Roethel)The New York State Department of Financial Services (NYDFS) has distributed notices

to more than 29,000 retail financial services firms within the state, updating proposed amendments to regulations requiring licensed insurance and annuity sales agents to be registered with the state. The proposed changes to state regulations were published in the New York State Register earlier this year. The Department of Financial Services, in keeping with its "regulatory modernization" approach, conducted a review of the

proposed regulations, and determined that no significant changes were necessary to NYDFS' existing licensing and registration requirements for insurance and annuity agents. All licensed sales agents and insurance or annuity producers will now be required to register with the state, pursuant to Article 17 of the general insurance law. Regulators determined this would more accurately reflect their statutory duty, and that in the absence of a geographic limitation to license

sales agents, an agent's primary employer should dictate where they are licensed. Accordingly, it was determined that any agent who devotes more than 20% of their time to the activities of a corporation or partnership should be licensed in that corporation or partnership. The proposed changes also added a new category of general agent license, for a "general agent" who is not licensed to sell insurance, annuity, or other non-insurance products. The Department of Financial Services

determined that the volume of insurance and annuity business in New York State exceeded the scope of the current insurance and annuity producer licensing regulations. Based on available data, the Department estimated the annual volume of insurance and annuity business in the state exceeds \$13 billion, with about half of that coming from New York City. Regulators determined that the "general agent" license would be regulated by Article 17, and subject to the same

registration requirements as other sales agents. The proposed changes would also add new terms and categories of agent licenses. Under the proposed regulations, licensees would no longer be classified as either "general agents" or "compensated" agents, but instead would be placed in one of four new categories: A. Basic Agent, subject to the registration requirements of Article 17, as in the current regulations. B. Licensed Insurer Representative, subject to the registration

requirements of Article 17, as in the current regulations. C. Licensed Annuity Representative, subject to the registration requirements of Article 17, as in the current regulations.
