Rios-Ortiz*, 830 F.2d 1067, 1069 (11th Cir.1987) (en banc ). Section 841 does not require the government to establish any precise quantity of drugs. *United States v. Consuelo-Gonzalez*, 865 F.2d 541, 545 (5th Cir.1989). Nevertheless, the government must still prove beyond a reasonable doubt that the defendant had actual or constructive possession of the drugs. *United States v. Wright*, 891 F.2d 209, 211 (11th Cir.1990). 15 The government met its burden of proof in this case by establishing that the defendant delivered a package containing drugs to a third party, and then re-entered the room before the delivery was completed. The defendant's subsequent entry into the room, combined with his later encounter with the other men, strongly suggests that he re-entered the room to complete the delivery, not to stop it. See *United States v. Bolts*, 558 F.2d 312, 316 (5th Cir.1977), cert. denied, 439 U.S. 898, 99 S.Ct. 262, 58 L.Ed.2d 246 (1978) (delivery completed before all parties left the room justified issuance of warrant for defendant's arrest for conspiracy to distribute heroin); see also *United States v. Simmons*, 567 F.2d 314, 315 (5th Cir.1977) (defendant's presence during delivery of package was sufficient to establish possession). 16 Furthermore, as the district court noted, the fact that the defendant had a prior record for drug abuse cast at least some doubt on his denials of involvement in the delivery. The finding of constructive possession in this case is further supported by the strong evidence of the defendant's continued interest in the package after it was delivered. 17 Because a reasonable jury could find beyond a reasonable doubt that the defendant had actual or constructive possession of the cocaine, the judgment of the district
