interpretation of clinical information has been perceived as the main duty of the medical professional. Nowadays, the importance of feedback from patients is becoming increasingly evident because it seems to give a more accurate measure of how well a doctor may have done and what the patient has considered to be the main problem. Receiving feedback from patients is in fact a complex process because several pitfalls need to be avoided. Among others, questions need to be answered: what kind of feedback should be given, when and how should it be given and what is the desired outcome? The answer to these questions is not obvious because we do not know the patient's expectations and hence the desired outcome. Also, it is not so simple to decide whether a certain clinical information is negative, positive, neutral or controversial. However, it seems that the biggest shortcoming is in the lack of formal guidelines. It is not clear whether the guidelines in use are valid or whether there are guidelines that are more suitable for this purpose. Neither is it clear whether these guidelines are implemented in clinical daily practice and if the profession is aware of them. It has been observed that when people receive feedback, they usually judge it by their own standards. If the feedback is negative, they may easily fall into a defensive posture. They may then engage in a defensive argumentation and resist making any kind of change, which might be because of their own feelings about what they consider to be "failed" care. These feelings may be diverse such as the idea that care is "not ready" or that care was "caused by incompetence on the part of the doctor". If, on the other hand, the feedback is positive, the receiver may get frustrated as a result of failure to meet expectations. In this case the situation will probably escalate because the receiver considers that the doctor is not accepting responsibility or is avoiding taking a stand on issues. The method that is suggested in this study is based on "facilitative" questions. It allows the recipient to reflect on the clinical information, before deciding how to react. This study suggests that this method can be used as a way of bridging the gap between expectations and reality. From a general perspective, it is obvious that the more we can act on the question of what the patient expected from the consultation and how that has been met, the more successful the care will be.
